Interacting Minds Centre 2018

2018 has been a year full of in-depth investigations and intense networking, but also a year that sowed a number of seeds, some of which are already sprouting. Several large research projects, e.g. *PLAYTrack, The Puzzle of Danish, Mobile Technologies and Mental Health* are in that early late phase, where data are being made sense of, findings become robust, and new ideas and frameworks are just about to emerge. Paradoxically, in the midst of all the daily humdrum, this is an ideal time to explore possible futures, and to incorporate new ideas and people.

IMC interfaces with a number of people and institutions, at AU and internationally, within academia and in relation to other sectors of society. We often see that across these very different domains, new attractors of activities and collaborations emerge. Thus, in 2018, collaborations with artists across different fields, e.g. literature, performance, installations, music, shifted from isolated incidences to an identifiable field of activities. On an institutional level, this was e.g. supported by a Novo Nordisk practice-based PhD fellowship to the visual artist Helene Nymann, and by a grant from Volkswagen Stiftung to fund an explorative workshop on Art-Science collaborations. These strands of activities, in turn, went into a new project, Experimenting, Experiencing, Reflecting Art and Science at work in the Public Realm, which was funded by the Carlsberg Foundation as a Semper Ardens Project (15 mio DKK, 2019-23). At the core of the project is a collaboration between IMC and Studio Olafur Eliasson, Berlin, aimed at developing new forms of 'interventions' which from a research perspective looks like experiments, from an artist perspective looks like art installations, and from the perceiver/participants point of view may allow for new forms of engagement and reflection. The project draws on a number of international collaborators across different sectors and fields and the first pilot interventions will take place at Aarhus Kunsthal and Tate Modern, London during summer 2019.

From September 2018 to April 2019, Andreas Roepstorff (IMC Director) was visiting fellow at Institute of Philosophy, School of Advanced Studies, University of London (IP), supported by a Leverhulme Visiting Professorship and by AU mobility funds. The theme of the project was *Collaborative Dynamics* with pre-Brexit UK presenting a fitting context. It involved a number of visits to UK universities, and this made it apparent how interdisciplinary institutions like IP, The Sackler Centre for Consciousness Studies at Sussex University, (and IMC) may allow for particular configurations of interaction. They can establish protected spaces for sustained work, while also creating 'wormholes' across departments, sectors and silos. Some of the tricks of the trade seems to be to insist that research is and should be a creative activity, that it involves genuine collaboration and dialogue, and that it thrives when it can live off and contribute to shared commons, which needs to be patiently nurtured and nourished.

This may not be the worst lessons for the future.
