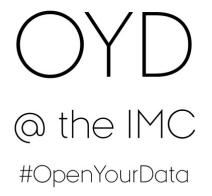
## Routine 1: Reflections

The aim of the reflection is to unpack and open up further the data problem by sharing what we notice in the data and what it makes us wonder. We want to explode the problem wide open to help the data owner fine tune and reflect on their research questions.



You can (but you don't have to) use this phrasing: 'In the data, I see (what do you see?). This makes me think (what do you think is going on?). And it makes me wonder (what does it make you wonder?)'

Please, don't provide solutions (yet). Instead: help us open up and complicate the data question further!

## Routine 2: Suggestions

The aim of the discussion is to rearrange and scaffold direction in the data problem by suggesting and trying out potential solutions in the next steps. We want this to be a 'solutions fitting room' for the data owner!

You can (but you don't have to) use the phrases: 'If I were you, I would consider trying (what would you do if it were your data?). Or: 'In the data, (what is remarkable to you?) is remarkable to me because (why?).

Please keep in mind that your suggestions and ideas are helpful even if your approach is completely different.
