Round 1 | Reflection See, think, wonder...

The aim of the reflection round is to unpack and open up the data problem by sharing what we notice in the data and what it makes us wonder. We want to explode the problem wide open to help the data owner fine-tune and reflect on their research questions.

We suggest that you wait with your ideas for solutions to the problem. Round 1 is an opportunity to open up the data problem. What new questions arise from your perspective?


You can (but you don't have to) use this phrasing: 'In the data, I see (what do you see?), which makes me think (what do you think is going on?), and it makes me wonder (what does it make you wonder?)'

Round 2 | Discussion Considerations & suggestions

The aim of the discussion round is to provide new ideas for solutions to the data problem. We encourage you to draw on your own research experience in suggesting potential next steps.

We like to think of this as a 'solutions fitting room' for the data owner! Please keep in mind that your suggestions and ideas are valuable even if your approach is completely different.

You can (but you don't have to) use the phrases: 'If I were you, I would consider trying (what would you do if it were your data?) or 'In the data, (what is interesting or remarkable to you?) is remarkable to me because (why?)'.



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
